Originally located on North Lewisburg Road spanning the Big Darby Creek, the bridge was moved to this North Lewisburg Trail location in 2006.</p>	<p>The Spain Creek Covered Bridge was designed and constructed by Reuben Partridge in the 1870s. The bridge was rehabilitated in 1988 by _____. The large wood girders and wood floor panels carry today's traffic load. The old wood trusses currently carry only their own weight as well as the weight of the roof and siding.</p>	<p>The New California Church was organized in 1826. On April 24, 1861, in the sanctuary of the second Presbyterian church built on this site, a congregational meeting was held to respond to the call from President Abraham Lincoln for _____.</p>	<p>This restaurant is on the National Registry.
